



Setting up a company in Latvia. Which form?

- Limited liability company (SIA) similar to Osakeyhtiö (Oy)
- Individual Merchant (IK) similar to Toiminimi (tmi)
- Joint stock company (AS) similar to Julkinen osakeyhtiö (Oyj)
- The most popular form of business so far is LLC (SIA)

Straightforward registration (SIA)

- Minimum equity is: 2800 EUR (cash or property contributions)
- Founders may be both natural and legal persons
- Documents can be submitted electronically
 - in a near future foreigners will have a possibility to apply for an eID card; that will also to use digital services fully
- Registration within 1-3 days
- Fee: 75-225 EUR



Start up ecosystem

- Startup law- two benefit scenarios:
 - 1) a special flat tax regime regardless of salary paid, combined with the 0% individual income tax rate, or
 - 2)45% co-financing for the highly qualified specialists
- Certain criteria to qualify for Startup Law benefits
- Certain criteria for Investor qualification



Human Resources

- Typically skilled and multilingual labour force
- The minimum wage: 500 EUR gross (for low-skilled workers)
- Relatively low number of public holidays
- Collective bargaining: generally binding collective agreements are only in railway, glass fibre and building industry
- Small and medium size private companies are typically not affected by collective bargaining



Attractive taxation system

- Corporate income tax: 0% on reinvested profit; 20% on dividends or if used for other purposes not directly related to business development
- Special taxation regimes in five Special Economic Zones (SEZ) Liepaja, Ventspils, Riga, Rezekne and Latgale, for example,
 - Up to 80% rebate on real estate tax (1.5% in Latvia)
 - 80% rebate on corporate income tax (dividends)
 - 80% rebate on withholding tax for dividends, management fees and payments for the use of intellectual property for non-residents (rates for each type of withholding tax vary)



What to remember

- Place for business is not only Riga depending of your business area, SEZ might be a better choice
- Latvia is rather small, taking into account distance work possibilities, quality workforce can be attracted also to areas outside Riga
- eID enables possibility to use state services electronically
- Trusted partners like accountants and lawyers, who speak your language and know the local market, will make your life significantly easier

 - 1 translator = 100 days






